- Lightroom Overview
 - \circ Overview:
 - LR creates "Catalogs" with Links to files; image enhancements & previews of files
 - Contains metadata: keywords; captions; collections; processing history; etc.
 - Non-Destructive!; You DO NOT "Save" changes to file- they are saved in Catalog
 - LR Workflow: Import/Develop/Output: to files, Print, Web, Slideshow or PDF. All instructions, previews, links to file remain in LR for future Develop and/or Output
 - Environment: [10]
 - Screen Real Estate 1200+; Modules w/Panels & sliders; Multiple Volumes (drives)
 - Menus, Keystrokes, <u>RT.MOUSE CLICK</u>
 - *Catalog Setting & Preferences (on our site)

II – Organize (Library module)*

- *Import 1: Existing Photos on Hard Drive (one-time?)

- o Creates catalog, Default Preferences, Identity Plate (very useful later when Outputting)
- Organize: Create "Super Folders"
- Move and Organize files & folders
 - Always through Lightroom: Moves/Organizes in your catalog AND on your Hard Drive!

- *Import 2: New Photos from Camera Card

- Common directory
- o On "Import" Auto Tone?, File naming, Copyright Info, General Keywording
 - create Copyright Info & File naming Template with "tokens"

- * Review Photo: Edit, Rate, Delete:

- Quick Process; Flag; Rate, Delete Rejected Photos;
 - Grid {G}; Loupe {E}; Survey {N}
 - Power of "Grid" View... Batch Process
 - Sync; Keyword
- Disperse throughout your Catalog

- *Export:

- Similar to "Save As" different paradigm
 - "Bake" LR adjustments into file and resolution of choice
 - think of these as "temporary files" not to be kept delete often
 - no need for multiple sized files just re-Export and
 - Templates Lightroom provide 3; you create your own

III – Develop (part 1) [Global Adjustments] General

- "Basic" Tools & Panel: - satisfy 80% of needs

- "Basic" Tools: Crop; Spot Removal; Red-Eye
 - Crop: Aspect Ratio; Compositional Aids "O" & "LLL"
 - Spot Removal (like "Rubber Stamp" / Creative Local Adjustments)
 Blemishes..."Heal" setting works best
 - Red-Eye
- o "Basic" Panel: "Tools; Treatment; Tone; Presence"

- *Develop: Fine tune your photos - "Best Practices

- A. "Basic" Tools:
 - Crop "R", (Spot Removal, Red Eye Correction if applicable)
- B. "Basic" Treatment: WB: (White Balance) use "Picker tool" {W} and *click on neutral area*
- C. Jack Davis' "4-Step Tango"
 - 1. **Tone**:
 - click "Auto" (extends dynamic range & finds Black and White points)
 - 2. Tone: Brightness and/or Contrast ("to taste... tells our story")
 - Fine tune sliders (I pick out most egregious 1st)
 - > You will probably "dance" back and forth with these sliders
 - 3. Tone: Recovery/Fill Light ("to taste... tells our story")
 - Recovery effects *HiLites (1/8th tones)* / Fill Light *Shadows (3/4 tones)*
 - 4. **Presence**: ("Enhancing step... as needed")
 - Clarity (edge contrast); Vibrancy (non-linear saturation); Saturation Notes: After adjusting:
 - Fill Light, Contrast and Brightness, you may need to re-find "Blacks" ("Alt + drag slider)
 - > Presence, Vibrance, you may need to re-adjust contrast and Brightness again
- D. Sharpen: use LR Develop Preset "Landscapes" or "Portraits" as needed

(see <u>"BobDs General Lightroom Workflow</u>")

- Quick Review of other Develop panels *(See video links) <u>Right</u>
 - Tone Curve: change "Point Curve"; drag & adjust; Adjust "Regions"
 - Vignettes: Post-Crop

IV - Cataloging- Keywords & Collections

- *Cataloging:

- o 3 levels: inherent to LR (camera metadata, folders, filenames) / Personal / Public
- Collections: "Quick", "Standard", "Smart", "Module"

- *Keywording

- Keyword Tags
 - <u>Don't enter in box</u>... Enter in "Click Here to add Keywords" [Ctrl+K]
 - Use "Keywords Tag" box to select multiple thumbnails and conform (remove "*")
 - Keyword Suggestions / Keyword Sets
- o Keyword List
 - Drag thumbnail to words and visa versa
 - Find all with that keyword

- Utilizing Quick Collection to gather "Finds"
- Organize in Hierarchy [New York (state) / New York (city)]
- Synonyms "groups" keywords" (not-exported)

- Search & Find

- Library Filter [in "Grid" view only... search occurs in the folder(s) and catalog(s) selected]
 - More powerful than just keyword: combine search terms, Save "custom" filters
 - Flags; Rating (Stars), Labels, Virtual Copies
 - ISO, Focal Length, F-stop, Aspect Ratio

V – Develop (part 2) [Selective Adjustments] Fine Tuning

- Creative Selective Adjustments

- TAT ["Target Adjustment Tool"] samples values under cursor
 - Mouse click & drag up (increase), down (decrease) Tone Curve; HSL
- *Graduated Filter (GF)
 - Can use multiple: darken sky; sharpen foreground
- *Adjustment Brush (AB)... [Selective Adjustments]
 - Tech Talk:
 - Brushes "A" "B" "Erase" (Feather /Soft edge)
 - "Auto Mask"... On/Off
 - Preview Mask... On/Off "O"
 - Multiple Attributes: Dodge / Burn / Sharpen & MORE! "Are you kidding me!" Note: Graduated Filter & Adjustment Brush use same Presets
 - Briefly discuss Exposure vs. Brightness:
 - Exposure: Compresses/Expands from/to White Point
 - Brightness Compresses/Expands from Mid-Grays (Brightness does not affect White or Black points)

- *Set Camera Defaults

- o Overview Discussion of Presets, Templates & Plug-ins
 - Powerful Develop and Templates in all Modules
 - Export & Develop Presets & Output Templates (Slideshow/Print/Web)
 - Develop Presets special, extra step... choose "Settings"
 - Copy similar templates, rename & Save... "Update" constantly when modifying
- *Create Camera Defaults

- *Camera Calibrate (Passport)

- Create unique calibration for shooting situation
- o general calibration
- o add to camera defaults

- Interfacing Lightroom with Photoshop:

- \circ utilize LR changes for PS production then imports new "edited" file in LR w/link
- Smart Objects; Panorama; HDR; Layers
- *Nik "Silver Efex Pro"
 - Open from LR to PS as "Smart Object" preferred
 - If only Lightroom may want to think of PS Elements

- *Export:
 - o "Library "Export" Button create and adjust then Quickly available from any Module
 - Create email with © copyright
 - Plug-in Manager: Flickr, Facebook, SmugMug, and more
 - LabPrint

- *Output:

- Mention Templates (Slideshow/Print/Web)
- Prints: Color Managed (save as template)
 - a) shut off your Printer Color Mgmt. from "Page Setup...",
 - b) in "Print Job" panel, change" Color Management: Profile" from "Managed by Printer" to the proper paper profile (must be loaded in LR)

- Develop Histogram Roll-over "white/black" ▲
 - "Alt + Exposure; Highlight, Black
- LR Color Picker in AB {Ctrl Drag Click}
- Change Time-Date Stamp on Files
